**Bistro Lepic** is an intimate French bistro and truly a hidden culinary gem tucked in the Burleith neighborhood in Georgetown.

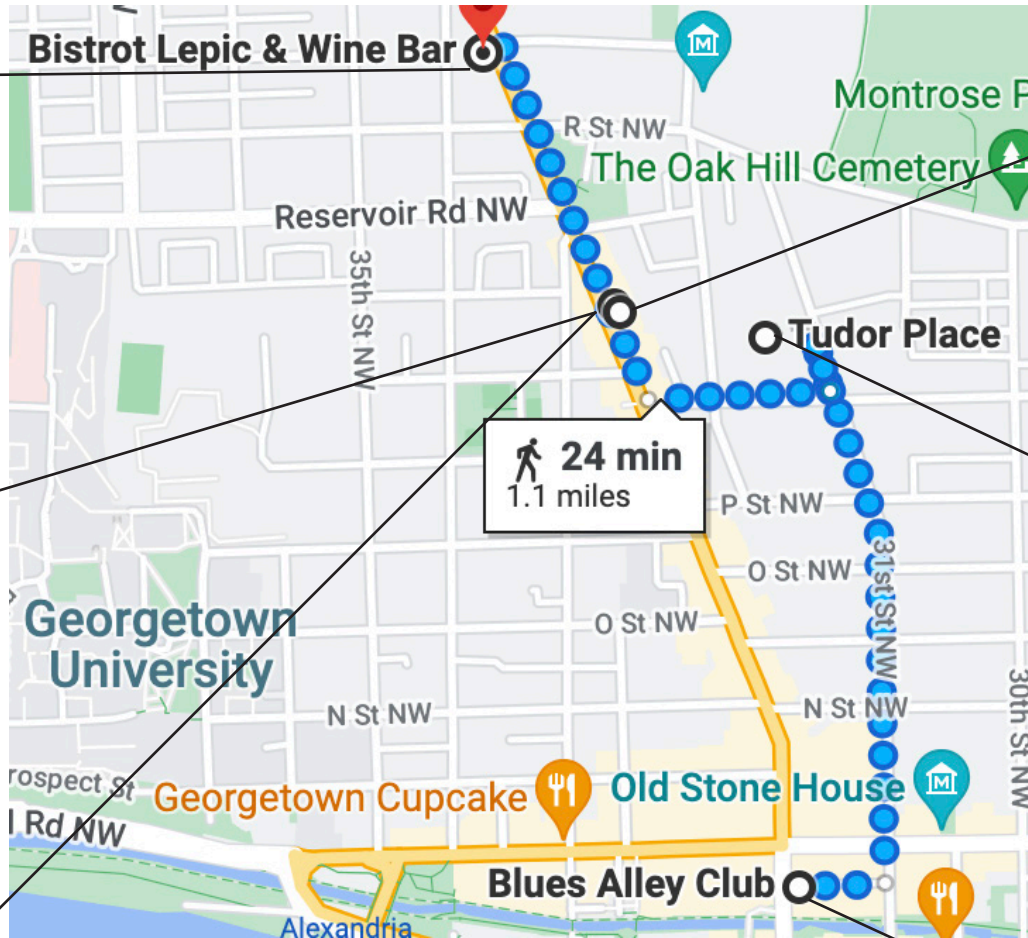

**Tudor Place Historic House & Garden** was the home of George Washington's great granddaughter Martha Peter (and her husband Thomas) and at least 14 of the 43 African American people they held in bondage. Though the beauty of the property is striking, my primary interest is in honoring and acknowledging the lives of these enslaved people (including Ibby, Patty Allen, Will Twine, Barbara Cole, Elvy, Will Johnson, Stacia, Hannah Pope, Charlie, Annie Gray, Brythe, Elizabeth, Nancey) and the other enslaved people who lived and worked there until the DC Emancipation Act in April 1862.
